

Senior Partner of CASALONGA & ASSOCIÉS since 1975, Axel Casalonga studied mechanical engineer in Zurich (ETHZ) and IP law in Paris where he obtained his doctor degree. He has practiced Industrial Property law since 1969. He is recognized as one of the most prominent patent specialist in France.

He is member of the Council of the European Patent Institute (epi) which groups all European Patent Attorneys and represents the profession before the European Patent Organization.

He was Chairman of the European Patent Practice Committee (EPPC) of the European Patent Institute (epi) from 1997 to 2005 where he drafted, organised and supervised numerous epi position papers on various subject matters.

He was involved in the discussions of the previous drafts of European Jurisdiction (EPAC, EPLA) which were held even before 2000.

Since 2011, Axel has been nominated Chairman of the Litigation Committee of the European Patent Institute (epi) which is preparing position papers for the EU Commission and the EU Council relating to the Unified Patent Court and its Rules of Procedures.

Axel Casalonga lectured on patent law at the CEIPI (International Center of Industrial Property) in Strasbourg for many years where he provided a basic course on the conditions for patentability in France and Europe.

He also lectured on patent litigation at the CEIPI since the creation of this course in 2004.
